Following that, she worked for a distributor of carpet and flooring products, and again called on designers and architects.

In 1987, Gail worked for a subsidiary of American Airlines as an interior design and facilities consultant for two fast-paced commercial joint venture projects with Hilton Hotels & Resorts®, Marriott and Budget®. It was around that time that friends began asking Gail to help them with their homes, and the idea of officially becoming an interior designer began taking form.

In 1990, after moving to Denver, Gail was awarded her Associate of Applied Science in Interior Design and completed her NCIDQ. Since then, Gail has received numerous design awards for remodeling excellence.

Gail's interior design career highlights include a range of award-winning, high-end renovation, design and construction projects for multi-million dollar estates. She built a nearly \$900,000 business in 2000 before 9/11. When business slowed down, she scaled back her operation so she could return to what she loved – construction design.

Gail's passion for teaching and transforming the industry were the reason she and Erin Weir, founded DSU in 2008. DSU is a shortcut to a more profitable and passion-filled interior design business whose mission is to help 10,000 (or more) designers build \$100,000+ businesses. DSU now serves over 10,000 interior designers in 45 countries.

DSU provides coaching, business consulting, VIP days for clients ready to take their \$150,000+ businesses to the next level. DSU offers several essential skill training class series and group coaching programs, educational



memberships, eBooks and white papers including the annual Interior Design Fee and Salary Survey digital book that has been downloaded over 9,500 times.

A member of the American Society of Interior Designers, Interior Design Society, Designer Society of America, Gail is is also NCIDQ certified. She and Erin still provide interior design services to her long-time clients.
